### Montmartre Legion #279

This month will highlight the Montmartre Legion Hall. In 1951, the new skating rink was open to the Legion so they had a place to hold their meetings. It seemed as though they held their meetings upstairs in the rink. In 1958, the Legion began a building fund as they, like most Legion branches, always wanted to have their own building. The Legion meetings were being held at that time in the village office or the municipal hall. In August 1960, the Legion tendered for a school building and their first choice was Low Prairie at \$951.55. They put the school beside the skating rink on block 54 lot 11 and 12. The Legion paid John Faubert \$250 to move it and they paid John Chorneyko \$90 to lay the blocks. Not long after they had their new building members held dances, bingo parties and many other events. In 1961, they rented their new Hall to the Knights of Columbus for their meetings. In 1962, Montmartre's School enrolment was so high that the school division had to have extra space. They rented the Legion Hall until 1966 and it became a classroom. In 1975, after 15 years of ownership, the Legion Hall was sold to Maurice and Cora Coueslan. 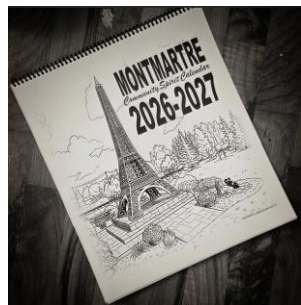
