Montmartre Legion #279

Our Montmartre Legion #279 was established and the cenotaph was built in 1946. The original membership consisted of over 30 veterans. Membership was \$1 and over the years has increased to \$35 in 2009 and now \$45 in 2026. For NEW members in 2026, to mark the 100th anniversary, Legion membership is FREE!

FYI: In 1948, the Legion took over the organizing of the annual sports day held every spring. That year they donated \$50 for pony and tractor races and \$35 for children's races. The Legion has sponsored athletes to go to track and field camps. They have donated to the new skating rink in 1950 and to the Rink expansion in 1983. From 1983 until recently, our Legion has sponsored the Army Cadet Corps. The Legion also donated sweaters to ball teams and hockey teams, furnished rooms at the hospital, organized and held dances, curling bonspiels. The Legion gives two athletic monetary wards to both a graduating male and a female each year.

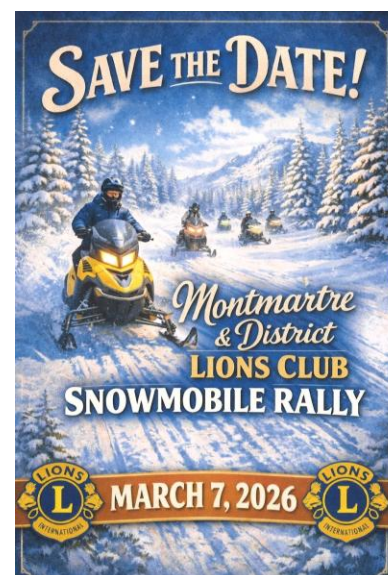

Snow Removal – sometimes snow plows go past your property just after you have finished shovelling your driveway and or sidewalk and we understand this can be frustrating.
