### **Village of Montmartre Info**

**Snow Removal** – sometimes snow plows go past your property just after you have finished shovelling your driveway and or sidewalk and we understand this can be frustrating. Snow removed from sidewalks can be placed on the adjacent property or on the road next to sidewalk, ensuring it doesn't interfere with traffic. Shovelling or blowing snow onto the street into the driving lane is a bylaw violation. Snow from driveways and private walkways should remain on the property.
