### ATTENTION: Dog and Cat owners

#### **Licence Fees:**

Dog and Cat licenses are due annually by **February 1<sup>st</sup>** of each year. If you have not acquired your pet's annual licence, please do so.

- All Dogs & Cats not spayed or neutered \$25.00
- All Dogs & Cats that are spayed or neutered \$15.00

#### **Unlicensed & Stray Animals**

Stray animals may be captured. If your pet is licensed and can be identified, you will be contacted within 24 hours. If your pet is unlicensed, you can call the Village of Montmartre office and provide them with a description of your pet in case it is picked up.

#### **Benefits of Licensing**

Licensing your pet helps to identify and protect your pet in case it becomes lost. Even indoor pets can get out and become lost. A pet licence is not only a requirement, but it provides the following benefits:

- A licence tells everyone that your pet is not a homeless stray.
- Licences enable the return of your missing pet to you as soon as possible.
- Animal licensing is an essential part of animal care and control in our community.

Also, please avoid the feeding of stray animals.
